## Reminders:

1. Field trips are a privilege. With that in mind, all students are expected to comply with the following guidelines:
  - Stay in groups.
  - The possession and/or use of illegal substances are **strictly forbidden**.
  - Luggage and room inspection can be held at anytime.
  - Students are not allowed in rooms of members of the opposite sex.

3. Bring \$\$ for dinner and/or purchasing concessions after your Sunday performance.
4. Please keep the buses clean.
5. Respect each other. No standing in buses or sitting on seat backs.
6. Remember to bring **everything** you need for your performance. Clearly mark your uniform bag with your name. Know your uniform and hat numbers. Keep track of your personal items, i.e. uniform, instrument, hat box, plume, gloves, shoes, etc. You will not perform if you are missing uniform parts.
7. We are only staying one night. EVERYONE is limited to one small suitcase. You only need a pair of pants, shirt, and/or sweatshirt or light-weight jacket (it can become quite cold). Personal items: toothbrush and toothpaste, deodorant, etc. Extra luggage simply will not fit on the bus with our instruments.
8. Your meals at the Fairfield are paid out of your trip costs. Meals are planned for nutrition as well as variety.
9. Concessions will be available at Merrill High School.
10. It will be a long weekend. Please respect others and their desire to study and/or sleep in your rooms and on the busses.
